As a Public Development Authority established in 2019, SREC undergoes regular audits to ensure the responsible management of public funds.

The results of the latest audit confirm that SREC:

- Maintains robust controls to safeguard public resources
- Demonstrates accountability, efficiency, and proper financial stewardship

About Spokane Regional Emergency Communications

Spokane Regional Emergency Communications (SREC) is a regionalized emergency response communications organization formed in 2018 as a Public Development Authority. Located in Spokane, Washington, SREC serves more than 550,000 citizens throughout the county as the primary PSAP for the region. In addition to answering emergency and non-emergency calls, SREC provides Fire and Law Dispatch services to 14 local Fire Protection Authorities and 7 local Law Enforcement Agencies in Spokane County. These services span more than 1,700 miles, and include management of more than 4,900 radios, 23 tower sites, and a backup center. SREC also writes reports for most of the law enforcement agencies in the region. SREC currently employ approximately 140 employees across the organization. SREC's mission is to get the right resources to the right location with an uncompromising focus on responder and citizen safety.
