**WHAT DOES
SEND PROTOCOL
DO?**

SEND is Designed to help answer calls for medical assistance from police— local law enforcement, sheriff, state police, highway patrol, security, military police or federal agents— The information that SREC needs will guide emergency dispatchers to more efficiently and effectively evaluate and record a reporting officer's onscene assessment, so they can send the most appropriate resources

**WHAT'S THE
BENEFIT OF
SEND?**

BETTER COMMUNICATION between the scene officers and dispatch

LESS TIME ON TASK for emergency dispatchers and scene officers, since required key information can be obtained

OPTIMIZED RESOURCES with only necessary resources being sent, based on the officer's on-scene evaluation. |

INCREASED SAFETY and LESS LIABILITY because more accurate information is provided
